2024 TOURNAMENT RULES

- The tournament is open to all anglers and all ages (See eligibility page).
- Official TOURNAMENT HOURS are from 6:30 am to 4:00 pm on the day of the tournament, rain, or shine.
- Wade, bank, surf, jetties, pier, or any legal means of fishing is permissible.
- Anglers must stay within line of site of their team members.

NO SAIL LINES OR TROTLINES are permitted. Fish must be caught on rod and reel only.

- Official WEIGH-IN starts at 2:00 pm and ends at 4:00 pm on the day of the tournament at the Ingleside Cove Park boat ramp. All anglers must be IN LINE with your fish (Only bring what you are weighing in. No fish culling while in line.) before 4:00 pm.
- Teams weigh in as a team and those who chose to fish as individuals weigh in as individuals.
- Cash payouts for 1st, 2nd & 3rd places will be awarded for the total combined stringer weight consisting of 3 Trout, 2 Redfish, and 1 Flounder (SLOT TROUT (15"-20" No oversize), SLOT REDFISH (20"-28"), FLOUNDER (15"-No Limit).
- You are not required to have a full stringer to weigh in.
- In the event of a tie, the winner will be decided by total length. If length is equal, the winner will be decided by time of weigh in.
- Mandatory: One member of your team must attend the captain's meeting.
- All fish weighed in and entered must be caught during official tournament hours on the day of the tournament.
- All fish presented for weigh-in will be monitored for freshness and will be inspected by a professional for tampering.
- All fish must be weighed-in by the entrant who originally caught the fish and must be in that entrant's physical possession at the time of weigh-in.
- Sportsmanship, courtesy, safety, and conservation are expected from all entrants.
- All game laws of the state of Texas, applicable to fishing on public waters, must be followed. Any violations will cause immediate disqualification. All winnings will be forfeited.
- Any entrant found to be in violation of any tournament rules and regulations will be subject to disqualification from this tournament and all future tournaments.
- ALL DECISIONS OF THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS AND WEIGH MASTER ARE FINAL.

NO OVERSIZED FISH OF ANY SPECIES WILL BE WEIGHED IN,
WHETHER THEY ARE TAGGED OR NOT.





ELIGIBILITY:

- All anglers must have a valid Texas fishing license.
- There are no age restrictions (minors must be accompanied by an adult).
- All state and federal penal code and game laws shall apply at all times.
- All Texas, Coast Guard and State Parks and Wildlife regulations shall apply at all times.
- Each angler must be a paid entrant of the tournament and must abide by all tournament rules and regulations.
- Tournament directors retain the right to refuse any entry.
- A Polygraph test may be required for 1st place 3rd place winners.

TPWD Length limits apply to listed saltwater species below.

Black drum (Side-Pot)

Min Length: 14 inches, Max Length: 30 inches

Red drum

Min Length: 20 inches, Max Length: 28 inches

Sea trout, spotted

Min Length: 15 inches, Max Length: 20 inches (No Oversize)

Flounder

Min Length: 15 inches, Max Length: No limit
